Georgia Cassimatis from the Northern Border Regional Commission, who helped fund the project came to enjoy the tour - her first time in the facility since it opened! The theatre has beautiful, open, well-lit spaces. The lobby is often full of the music of Louise and Bernie, there is a small event and film space upstairs that can be rented for performances or rehearsals, and there is of course the main theatre with fantastic acoustics, professional lighting, and the most comfortable seats we've ever enjoyed in a theatre! 
