

When the pandemic led to clients cancelling live events, effectively

Last month we proudly announced new a minigrant program aimed at artists and creative businesses in the Monadnock Region. Applications for mini-grants of \$50-\$250 are now open until October 31. Grants will be aimed at and awarded to projects that help artists or

creative businesses expand their professional abilities or increase how many people they can reach with arts experiences.

"We're going to be really flexible with how this money can be used," says Executive Director Jessica Getler.
